2017 Wyoming Natural Resources Rendezvous Youth Convention Scholarship

The Wyoming Stock Growers Association (WSGA) is offering 6 scholarships to Wyoming college students to attend the 2017 Wyoming Stock Growers Association and Wyoming Association of Conservation Districts Natural Resources Rendezvous, November 27-30 at the Ramkota Hotel & Conference Center in Casper, Wyoming.

WSGA is a statewide membership organization serving the needs of Wyoming's livestock producers through advocacy and promotion. Scholarship recipients will have the opportunity to network with livestock and natural resource industry members, specialists, employers, and leaders. They will participate in discussions about current issues and will witness presentations about the latest and most relevant industry information available.

Each scholarship will cover the cost of one full convention registration, which includes all convention programs, meetings, and meals. Recipients will also be matched with a mentor who will help the student network with WSGA and WACD members, speakers, help them through the committee process as well as explain important issues affecting the beef industry and our natural resources. Recipients are responsible for lodging (\$75 per night room charge) at the Ramkota Hotel & Conference Center and travel expenses to Casper, Wyo. To apply, applicants must submit a one-page essay explaining how relations between environmentalists, natural resource personnel and ranchers could be improved or how that relationship has been restored in some way and how they plan to advocate for the agricultural industry. Students must also fill out an application form (below). Applicants must be a student of the University of Wyoming or a Wyoming Community College. The essay and application form must be submitted to Haley Clark at haley@wysga.org or mailed to 113 E. 20th St. – Cheyenne, WY 82003.

Deadline is Wednesday, November 15, 2017. The 6 winners are chosen by the WSGA staff and will be notified by Monday, November 20, 2017 by email. Additional details will follow in the coming weeks after notification to the scholarship winners.
